



Travel to Oxford

Oxford is well served by public transport from a number of major airports and international stations including London Heathrow, London Gatwick, Birmingham airport and St Pancras International.

Airline Bus

The Oxford Airline provides a very frequent, 24 hour coach service between Oxford and Heathrow, Gatwick and Birmingham airports. Featuring free wi-fi, this service is both comfortable and reasonably priced. Approximate fares as follows:

Heathrow to Oxford Return £30 / Gatwick to Oxford Return £37 / Birmingham to Oxford Return £25

Trains

For those travelling to Oxford from London, trains run regularly between London Paddington and Oxford train station with an average journey time of around 1 hour. From Oxford train station it is a 15 minute walk to the city centre. For those staying in North Oxford, there is also a frequent service between London Marylebone station and Oxford Parkway.
